In 1998, John Wood, who was an executive at Microsoft decided to take a rare and hard-won vacation. While he was warming himself at an inn one evening, John met a regional school inspector. They drank beer together, discussed Nepal's low literacy rate. John was suggested to accompany the inspector to make a visit to a remote rural school on the following morning, and he agreed on it.

After hiking for hours on steep, switchback trails, they finally reached the school. What he saw there was hundreds of students who were eager to study packed in a classroom. However, they had not been offered a learning environment; no desks, no learning materials and only a few books locked in a cabinet in the library.

(ウ) John was really shocked with this situation. Noticing John's shocked reaction, the headmaster said something that would change John's life: "Perhaps, sir, you will someday come back with books."

Back at Microsoft, John could not help thinking about his experiences in Nepal. He started to collect children's books from his friends and at the same time, he studied about the educational inequality around the world. After a particularly heartening experience delivering books to the school that had originally inspired him, he made up his mind to quit his job and commit himself to bringing books and education to disadvantaged children in Nepal. At last in 2000, he founded an organization named Room to Read.

Upon the foundation of Room to Read, John set a clear vision that he would (エ) 10 million children in the developing countries with access to education. With his strong business skills, John started with his work in collaboration with rural communities in Nepal. At first, he built a school and a school library in the village. And, gradually his work expanded—from Nepal to Vietnam, Cambodia, India, Laos, Sri Lanka, South Africa and Zambia. At present, two more countries, Bangladesh and Tanzania are added to the project, and they have been working in these (オ) countries in order to transform the lives of children by focusing on literacy and gender equality in education.
